# Minutes of Meeting held on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2008 in the School Hall commencing at 7.30 p.m.

**PRESENT** Mr. D. Haywood (Chairman), Mr. D. Dixon, Mr. A. Longdon, Mr. K Walton, Mr. P. Horsfall, Mr. P. Kirton, Mr. P. Preece and Mrs. J. Burgess (Clerk)

- **1. APOLOGIES** were received from Mrs. M. Wilkinson (illness), Mr. R. Crawford (work commitments), Mrs. M. Shineton and Mr. P. Martin.
- **2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.** Mr. D. Haywood declared a Prejudicial Interest in Item 6.1 and left the room whilst the application was being discussed and took no part in the voting.
- 3. MINUTES OF THE FEBRUARY MEETING. These were taken as read, amended, approved and signed proposed by Mr. D. Dixon, seconded by Mr. P. Kirton.

### 4. MATTERS ARISING.

- 1. MILESTONE MAINTENANCE. We were still awaiting a response from S.C.C. re this matter.
- 2. SEVERN LODGE FARM WATER PROBLEM. No contact had been made and the matter would be chased.
- 3. SEVERN TRENT VISIT TO PARISH RE PROBLEMS AFTER PIPEWORK WORK. Still awaiting a response from S.C.C. re this matter.
- 4. MISSING DRAIN COVERS ON HIGHLEY ROAD. We had been advised that these had now been replaced.
- 5. BUS SHELTER AT WOODLANDS. After discussion it was agreed to point out to S.C.C. that whilst there was no room within the site for buses to turn round, buses had stopped outside here for many years and people have to stand on the verge waiting for transport. In fact it was thought that this point was even a Whittles fare stage. In the present climate of trying to encourage travel on public transport and the issue of free bus passes to users which would hopefully encourage more travel on public transport, it was felt that further consideration should be given to the matter.
- 6. BOUNDARY CHANGES invitation from Stottesdon P.C. to attend meeting to discuss proposals and details re Boundary Committee's draft recommendations consultation period. Agreed not necessary at this point.
- 7. WOLVERHAMPTON AIRPORT ACTION GROUP re 'preferred option' response. No further comments considered necessary.
- 8. CLEOBURY COUNTRY Country Fair Sunday May 25<sup>th</sup>. Proposed by Mr A. Longdon and seconded by Mr. P. Horsfall and agreed by all that a donation of £100.00 be made with an offer of assistance on the day.

## 6. PLANNING APPLICATIONS.

- 1. 08/0154 for Mr. D. Haywood for use of land for stationing of 6 mobile homes, alterations to vehicular access and installation of a septic tank at The Lawns Farm, Kinlet. As Mr. Haywood declared a prejudicial interest, he left the room during the discussion and took no part in the voting, Mr. A. Longdon (Vice Chairman) took the chair for the discussion. It was a majority decision to recommend approval for holiday use (there was one abstention) Mr. A. Longdon proposing and Mr. P. Kirton seconding.
- 2. 08/0137 for Mr S. Kilsby for installation of a flue for woodburning stove at Courtyard Cottage, Winnal Court, Kinlet. Unanimous decision to recommend approval Mr. P. Horsfall proposing and Mr. P. Preece seconding.
- 3. HRN/08/0015 re removal of 3 lengths of hedgerow (1x44/1x58/1x103 metres) at Mawley Town Farm due to hedge planted on steep bank causing safety problems to farm machinery. Unanimous decision to recommend approval Mr. A. Longdon proposing and Mr. P. Preece seconding.
- 4. S.C.C. re proposed diversion FP37 (part) and FP33 (part). Also proposed extinguishment FP29. Unanimous decision to recommend approval proposed by Mr. A. Longdon and seconded by Mr. D. Dixon.
- 5. S.C.C. for renewal of temporary planning permission for retention of 5-bay demountable classroom unit at Kinlet CE Primary School, Kinlet. Unanimous decision to recommend approval proposed by Mr. P. Horsfall and seconded by Mr. P. Kirton.
- 6. 08/0180 for Mr. P. Forrest for removal of agricultural occupancy condition attached to planning permission ref. 85/0243 at Pancake Farm, Kinlet. It was a unanimous decision to recommend refusal on the grounds that 1) the property has not been sufficiently advertised to match the scale of the accommodation available, both in relation to the type of advertising medium used and the lack of signage outside the property. It should also be taken into account the down trend in the property market during the past months and currently which was not conducive to a sale of this type of property without extensive advertising 2) No advertising appeared to have taken place in relation to renting the property which it was believed was a requirement of such an application. 3) Had a correct valuation been placed on the property felt somewhat high with the agricultural occupancy condition. B.D.C. would be asked to discuss in full committee.
